JUDGE: John Hope, Levelland, TX

John has taught in the Fine Arts department at South Plains College since 2004. Prior to that, he taught art in Levelland Public Schools for 29 years. John's drawings, paintings, prints and sculpture have been represented in numerous solo and group exhibitions. A native of Levelland, John graduated from South Plains College with an Associate of Arts degree in 1972. He studied under professors, Don Stroud and Burl Cole, and worked on various projects with each, primarily studying the art of mosaics. John also holds a BFA and MAE from Texas Tech University. He studied traditional mosaic techniques in Ravenna, Italy, at Studio Arte del Mosaico, in 2005.

CATEGORIES: 1. Oils and Acrylics 2. Watercolors 3. Pastels 4. Photography 5. Jewelry: lampwork beads, silver smithing enameling, etc. 6. Pottery and Turnings 7. Sculpture 8. Miscellaneous: drawing, pen and ink, mixed media, collage, silkscreen, glass, metal, plastic, mosaic, wood, fiber.

ELIGIBILITY: Entries must be original works of art, completed within the last two years, and not previously shown in an LEAA show. All entries must be hand delivered. Persons entering must be at least 16 years of age.

AWARDS: For each category: \$200 Best of Show; \$75 - 1st place; \$50 - 2nd place; \$25 - 3rd place. Ribbons awarded for Honorable Mention

ENTRY FEES: \$5.00 per entry for LEAA members; \$8.00 per entry for non-members. Memberships will be available at registration of entries: \$10 Lea County residents, \$15 outside of county.

SALES: 20% commission charged on all sales; work may be labeled NFS (not for sale)

SPECIFICATIONS: Two-dimensional works must be framed and wired for hanging. Artwork with saw tooth or string hangers will not be accepted. LEAA reserves the right to reject artwork not appropriately wired or considered to be in poor taste. Artwork must hang for the duration of the show. No wet paint accepted.
